
Three Upcoming Regional Campus Safety Summits

New Partnership with Houston Community College for the Gulf Coast Campus Safety Summit

Jana's Campaign advocates for increased efforts by colleges and universities to prevent genderbased violence in their campus communities. This year, the Gulf Coast Campus Safety Summit (GCCSS) will convene at Houston Community College, recognized for its proactive measures in addressing these concerns. In alignment with our ongoing partnership with the Harris County Domestic Violence Coordinating Council, the GCCSS will be hosted at the West Houston Institute in Houston, TX. We encourage campuses to send multi-disciplinary teams to attend, increasing the impact of the Summit on each campus represented. We are committed to hosting a wide range of campus safety representatives at the Summit, and invite campus personnel from Texas, Louisiana, Alabama, Mississippi, Georgia, and Florida.

Collaborative Partnership with the Kansas Coalition Against Sexual and Domestic Violence

Increasing Impact Through Continued Work with Kansas Department of Health and Environment

Jana's Campaign has successfully secured an additional partnership opportunity with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for two grant initiatives. Building upon prior projects, *Jana's Campaign* will lead training sessions focused on the evidence-based program, Coaching Boys Into Men. This program empowers middle and high school coaches to teach healthy relationship skills to their young male athletes, emphasizing that strength never stems from violence. Through our collaborative efforts, these training sessions are readily accessible, free of charge, to male athletic teams across Kansas.



Through a new initiative this year, in collaboration with Options Domestic & Sexual Violence Services (Hays, KS), we aim to conduct a comprehensive community needs assessment for the prevention of sexual violence in Ellis, Thomas, and Russell Counties in Kansas. Following the outcomes of this assessment, Options and *Jana's Campaign* will deliver training, expanded services, and other preventive measures to reduce the prevalence of sexual violence within these communities. We express our gratitude for the opportunity to undertake these projects in partnership with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.
